

## **SUNDAY PRAYERS**

### ***Sign of the Cross in the Divine Will:***

*In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, within the Holy and Divine Will of God.*

### ***Opening Prayers:***

Mother Mary, we love you and you love us, give us a sip of the Divine Will of God to our soul. We fuse the past, present and future of all mankind into your maternal and sorrowful heart, with a kiss and I love you.

### ***Holy Spirit Prayer (Choose one):***

Come Holy Spirit, come by means of the powerful intercession of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Your well-beloved spouse.

- OR -

Come Holy Spirit, be with us as we pray, we call upon you to ignite the fire within us so we will be one with Our Savior, Jesus. Come, Holy Spirit, bless us with an infinite love and a faith to overcome all trials and help us to be one with Christ.

### ***Invocation to the Divine Will***

We are nothing, God is everything, we love You Father; Come Divine Will, continue:

- thinking in our minds
- seeing in our eyes
- hearing in our ears
- talking in our voices
- breathing in our breathing
- flowing in our blood
- beating in our hearts
- moving in our movements
- walking in our steps
- working in our hands

- suffering in our sufferings, and since our souls are united to You, let us be Your living crucifixes offered in sacrifice for the Father's glory.
- praying in us, and then by offering this prayer to yourself as ours it will be as if everyone had prayed and will give the Father the glory that all creatures should give Him.
- infuse in us the Faith of Mary most Holy in order to possess You as she possessed You.
- infuse in us the Hope of Mary most Holy in order to desire You as she desired You.
- infuse in us the Charity of Mary most Holy in order to love You as she loved You.
- adore in us, and since Your Will multiplies acts to the infinite, thus we intend to give You the satisfaction if all had assisted at Holy Mass and give to all the fruit of the sacrifice.

O Supreme Will, come to reign upon the earth. Invest all generations win and conquer all!  
And do not delay any longer. Amen.

### ***Invocation***

V. Blessed be the Holy and Undivided Trinity, now and always, forever and ever

**R. Amen.**

V. O Lord, open my lips.

**R. And my mouth shall proclaim Thy praise.**

V. O God, come to my assistance.

**R. O Lord, make haste to help me.**

V. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost.

**R. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.**

### **Preparatory Act**

O Most Merciful God, Unity in Essence and Trinity in Persons, behold here one of Thy humble creatures, who recognizes within itself the venerable image of Thy Most Holy Trinity. I confess that I have not fulfilled my obligations with the honor to which this divine likeness obliges me. I have sinned, my God, but I never denied Thy Trinity. Rather, I have firmly believed in the Father, in the Son, and in the Holy Ghost: that the Father has no beginning; that the Son is begotten of the Father, with Whom He is consubstantial; and that the Holy Ghost is the object of the reciprocal love of the Father and Son, from Whom He proceeds and with Whom He is consubstantial; and the Father is not superior to the Son, nor are they superior to the Holy Ghost. I adore the Father as God, the Son as God, and the Holy Ghost as God; nevertheless, in the Three I believe and adore only a Single God. I do not understand this mystery, O Lord, by my understanding is fascinated by virtue of Faith, for Thy greater glory and my merit. I offer these most profound sentiments of piety, of reverence and of love, as most pleasing supplications of Thy sanctity, so that through them Thou mayest forgive so many offenses committed by me against Thy uncreated majesty. O Most Blessed Trinity! The miserable trinity of my faculties sighs for Thee: my memory, tainted by weakness; my understanding, infected by ignorance; my will, perverted by the inclination to evil. Heal me, sanctify me, and give me help so I may never lack the intentions with which Thou hast deigned to inspire me; for I promise to dedicate myself, from now on, to upholding the dignity of the practices that correspond to Thy own character, with which Thou hast sealed me; to appreciate it as fully as I possibly can with Thy grace; and to avail myself of Thy grace to preserve in devotion and in the mystery of Thy Most August Trinity, in Whom I hope to find mercy, compassion and benevolence forever. Amen.
